

HUNTINGTON COUNTY MODELERS
SAFETY RULES
(as of Jan 07)

1. Internal combustion engine operation is not permitted before 8 AM.
2. Except for takeoff or landing, flying is not permitted within the area bounded by Meridian Road and the runway centerlines. See airfield diagram.
3. Fliers should announce when making landings or low passes over the runway.
4. Intentional flying over the pit or spectator areas is not permitted.
5. Any model with an engine running and within the pits must be secured by hand or mechanical device; taxiing included.
6. Flyers must have the appropriate channel number attached to their transmitter in such a manner as to be clearly visible to other flyers.
7. Flyers must use the frequency board and transmitter impound, except for those fliers using HAM and 27 mhz frequencies. Those fliers are responsible for their own frequency coordination.
8. Frequency pins will be labeled with the flier's name and channel number on both sides of the pin.
9. Fliers must attach a frequency pin to the frequency board before turning on the appropriate transmitter.
10. Frequency pins will be removed from the impound board when the appropriate transmitter is not in use.
11. Fliers must stand in the immediate vicinity of one of the four flying positions which are marked by a concrete block; excluding helicopter pilots which may stand nearer to the designated practice area when hover practicing.
12. Engines will not be operated over one-quarter throttle when within the pit area; excluding one-half A engines.
13. Extensive engine testing and troubleshooting will be done in the designated area only. See airfield diagram.
14. Unsupervised children and pets are not allowed in the pit area.
